Basketwork - Overview of the European Union market

Product description

This market brief covers small articles of basketwork which are mainly imported from developing countries and which are classified under the following code:

CN 4602.10-91 Basketwork and other articles made directly from vegetable plaiting materials.

Trade

During the period 1989-1993, the overall imports of basketwork increased by 13% in terms of volume (25% during 1989-1992). In 1993, however, demand for basketwork declined due in part to the recession which influenced consumer spending patterns for accessory articles of basketwork.

Germany is the largest importer of basketwork in the European Union accounting for approximately one-third of total imports, followed by the United Kingdom, France and the Netherlands. Details are given in annex I.

Main origins of imports

The main supplier of basketwork, in terms of volume, is China which accounted for almost 57% of total EU imports in 1993. Other major suppliers of basketwork were the Philippines (8.0%), Poland (7.3%) and Romania (6.7%). The Netherlands was the fifth largest supplier in 1993 with 3.8%; however, as domestic production of basketwork is extremely limited, data mainly reflect re-exports.

Market characteristics

Basketwork is both utilitarian and an accessory. In both cases, the consumption of basketwork has increased significantly in recent years. This can be attributed to the renewal of product lines and the development of new distribution channels in this sector, in particular through mail-order sales and department stores offering very high quality basketwork articles.

Articles can be either hand-made or machine-made, the former relying mainly on cottage industries. The main raw materials required are rattan cane, bamboo and leaves. Product assortment is extensive, catering to a wide range of consumer preferences.

The environmental trend has influenced colour lines and products with natural colors are the most popular (completely unbleached or decorated with a few coloured fibres). There is also a pronounced preference for warm colours (such as brown, red) and pastels (such as mauve).

Basketwork products are in demand throughout the year with seasonal peaks during Christmas when emphasis is given to gifts and ornamental articles, and in the summer for beach articles. Both utilitarian and ornamental articles are in demand, such as:

- **accessories for the home:** light fittings, hanging plant pots, umbrella stands, magazine stands, pet baskets;
- **household articles:** laundry baskets, shopping bags and baskets;
- **decorative articles:** glass mounts, table mats, mirror frames;
- **various trays and containers:** articles for plants, flowers and confectionery, including bread baskets;
- **baby items:** cradles and baby baskets;
- **small furniture items:** chairs, light furniture for children, small tables, garden furniture;
- **luggage items:** trunks, bags, cases.

Market access

Under the GATT, the percentage duty rate applicable to imports of basketwork is 3.7% under the tariff heading HS 4602.

Prices

Given the wide range of products available on the market, a discussion on prices is beyond the scope of this market brief. However, it is important to note that the high transport costs represent between 30% and 50% of the initial value of product. China's major share of the market is due to its very competitive prices.

Packaging

Packaging is extremely important to the success of trade in handicrafts since it affects the importer's perception of the overall quality of the goods. Basketwork must be well protected from moisture and mould before shipping. Drying methods at that stage are very important as well as treatment with fungicides. Items must not be damaged during transit and since most basketwork is sensitive and easily squashed, it is recommended to use cartons and to avoid loose packaging. Do note that importers usually prefer to pay after inspection of the goods. It is possible to minimize transport costs by shipping an assortment of articles in a container.

Trade promotion

Various trade events are organized in the handicrafts sector in the European Union; details of trade fairs are given under Useful addresses. These events allow traders to keep themselves informed of new styles and to make contacts. Potential exporters should prepare detailed and informative material about their company and its products, including price lists and delivery capacity. Exporters should also access trade journals and specialized magazines which, together with consumer magazines, are the major advertising media (see Useful addresses).

Distribution channels

The bulk of the trade is handled by specialized importers. Some retailers import on a small scale. Major multiples and central buying groups have their own suppliers. The main outlets are department stores, specialized stores (such as IKEA), supermarkets and chain stores. A list of importers is given in annex II.

Market opportunities

The EU market, despite some fluctuations and a slight decrease in 1993, is expanding, and importers are constantly seeking new sources of supply. There is therefore scope for sales of products originating in other developing countries. Exporters should note, however, that competition is already fierce. Assistance from EU importers to artisans in developing countries can help strengthen the handicraft industry and develop new products. The table below shows trend projections of imports over the period 1996-1998. Germany is expected to maintain its position as the main importer, followed by the Netherlands which registered the highest growth over the period 1989-1993.

In recent years, large distribution networks have established their own retail outlets throughout the European Union, creating a demand for larger shipments and wider product ranges. This trend will affect manufacturers and exporters in developing countries where basketwork production is mainly based on cottage industries. One approach for small- and medium-size enterprises would be to group export orders or establish export consortia in order to maintain or increase market share, as well as facilitate market entry.
